Option 1: Computerized testing on a drop-in basis

Location: Assessment Lab (SS-250)

Dates: April 7 – August 29 (Closed June 23 – 27)

Hours: Mon.-Thurs. 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Wed. until 6:45 p.m., beginning April 16.

- Testing must be completed by closing.
- Allow 2 hrs. for English and 1-2 hrs. for Math
- Lab hours and result availability are subject to change.
- Math Results are immediate
- English Results: Mon./Tues. test results available Wednesday, Wed./Thurs. results on Friday

Option 2: Two-day Assessment/Orientation/Registration

Location: Administration Bldg., A-211

Dates: Thursday/Friday paper/pencil tests on these dates only: **June 12 & 13; June 19 & 20; July 10 & 11; July 17 & 18; July 24 & 25; July 31 & Aug 1; Aug 7 & 8; Aug 14 & 15**

Student Schedule:

Day 1 Check-in: 12:30 p.m., **Orientation to College:** 1:30 – 4:30 p.m., **Optional tours:** 4:30 – 6:45 p.m.
Day 2 English & Math Assessment: 8:30 – 11:45 a.m., **1st Semester Plan & Registration:** 12:30 – 2:30 p.m.

Testing Essentials:

- **Are you required to assess?** See details listed under 'Alternatives to Testing'. **Are you from out-of-the-area?** See best choices for test dates listed under 'Out-of-Area-Students'.
- **Photo ID** and #2 pencil required for all testing. Know your SBCC Student I.D. number, located at your individual student Pipeline account.
- **Do you need accommodation for disability?** Contact the Disabilities Specialists, Rm. SS-160 (805) 965-0581, ext. 2364) for permission *prior to testing*.
- **Math testers:** Be sure to complete the **REAP Test Preparation Form**, available on this website. **Sample test questions** are also available at this site.
- **Your application** should be submitted before Assessment tests are taken, so that you may use your student number for testing purposes.
