Location: Assessment Lab (SS-250)

Dates: November 3 – January 30
(closed Winter Break, Dec. 22 – Jan. 1) **No testing after the first week of classes.**

Hours: Mon.-Thurs. 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Wed. until 6:45 p.m., beginning November 12.

- Testing must be completed by closing.
- Allow 2 hrs. for English and 1-2 hrs. for Math
- Lab hours and result availability are subject to change.
- Math Results are immediate
- English Results: Mon./Tues. test results available Wednesday, Wed./Thurs. results on Friday, beginning November 12.
