For most students, assessment consists of taking an English test and one of 4 different math tests. There are exemptions or alternatives to testing, however, so you will want to access College resources to find out if you have already satisfied the requirement. Please continue with step 1, below:

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English Test Preparation

The English test consists of assessment of your reading and writing skills. Included in the exam is a 20-minute essay on a general topic. You *should* read the sample English test to familiarize yourself with what types of questions will be included. **Please download a copy of the [Sample English test](#) at www.sbccc.edu/assessment.**

Mathematics Test Preparation

In order to account for the different math backgrounds of our students, the College offers four different math tests. People tend to forget math when they are not using it, therefore, a review of your math skills is essential. Please follow the guidelines listed below:

Which math test is appropriate for my background? Check one box only.

- I have successfully completed 2 years of high school algebra, one year of geometry and trigonometry, or 4 years of high school math including trig., analytical geometry, or advanced topics. **Review Math Test #4.**
- I have successfully completed 2 years of high school algebra plus one year of geometry. **Review Math Test #3.**
- I have completed at least 1 year of high school algebra. **Review Math Test #2.**
- I have completed basic mathematics or pre-algebra. **Review Math Test #1.**

It is critical to your success to review before testing, and to take the highest numbered test that matches your math background, as well as your current abilities. Download the appropriate [sample math test](#) at www.sbccc.edu/assessment now, and work the problems. The answers are at the bottom of the page. Your performance on the sample will help you decide if you are ready for a particular test. **If you have forgotten your math, buy the more extensive study packet** in the College bookstore (805) 963-4661 and study the areas that need review.
