The Curriculum Advisory Committee monitors and recommends the development, revision, and maintenance of the Associate Degree requirements and General Education. The General Education and the requirements for the Associate Degree are printed in the catalog which is available for viewing on the District's website.

In addition, the District will ensure that its educational programs are consistent with its institutional mission and in alignment with the needs of the community.
