



AP 5035 WITHHOLDING OF STUDENT RECORDS

Reference:

Title 5 Section 59410

Admissions & Records may withhold grades, transcripts, diplomas, and registration privileges from any student or former student who fails to pay a proper financial obligation to the District. Students or former students shall be notified, via the student portal that a financial hold has been placed on their record and privileges are suspended. Students shall be provided the opportunity to appeal if the financial obligation is in error.

The definition of proper financial obligation shall include, but is not limited to: student fees; obligations incurred through the use of facilities, equipment or materials; library fines; unreturned library books; materials remaining improperly in the possession of the student; and/or any other unpaid obligation a student or former student owes to the District. A proper financial obligation does not include any unpaid obligation to a student organization.

The administrator responsible for student discipline or designee may withhold registration and/or records for students who under suspension, academic or progress probation/disqualification or are in violation of any of the Standards of Student Conduct.
