Article I (Name of the Club)

Article II (Purpose)

The purpose of SBCC CC is to create a space for students to come together to share faith and build community. We plan to have a number of events for the club ranging from lunches at school on the grassy hill to mass on the beach with local priests. We will also be informing students about the happening of other Catholic clubs, organizations and young adult groups in town. We will be doing community outreach in the form of volunteering as well and give resources to pregnant and single mothers, hoping to provide baby food to the pantry, Christmas presents to the kids in the preschool and resources at the Well for those who are looking for spiritual counseling or guidance.

Article III (Authority)

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV (Membership)

Anyone is welcome to join the club, any faith or denomination, people who believe in God or don't. We want to make this an inclusive space for those students who are Catholic on campus as well as build a community for SBCC students in general to learn more about being Catholic and be involved in the church.

Article V (Board)

President: Presides all meetings. Call for meetings.Plans events and gather resources. Point of contact.
Vice President: Supports president. There in case of the president's absence.Helps with planning events.
Secretary: Keep records of each meeting.
Treasurer: Keep financial records.

Article VI (Meetings)

We will hold a meeting every other week where we discuss upcoming events and plan volunteering and community outreach. We will also hold fundraisers to support causes that the club agrees on like helping other organizations, covering club expenses and bringing in speakers.

Article VII (Elections)

Elections will be held for the club positions at the second club meeting of the semester each year.

Article VIII (Amendments)

There must be 50% of voting members present to change specific club amendments. The club officers must also ask the advice and council of all club members in attendance.
