

HISTORY CLUB

ARTICLE I

This organization shall hereafter be referred to as the History Club of SBCC and will serve the currently enrolled students of SBCC who are interested in ant and all aspects and periods of history.

ARTICLE II

All members will have equal voting rights – a simple majority is required to carry a measure. No quorum is required to initiate the vote.

Article III

Membership is open to any student who is an active participant.

ARTICLE IV

Officers will be elected each semester:

President – directs the meetings and club projects and shall act as a figurehead and represent the club in full capacity.

Vice/President – shall act as liaison between the advisor, officers and members.

Treasurer – shall handle all financial matters and manage the club's assets.

ARTICLE V

Club meetings will be held bi-monthly. Special meetings can be called by officers and are subject to vote.

ARTICLE VI

Amendments to the constitution shall be made by the members, by a vote of a simple majority and subject to the quorum requirements.
