  - C. Retaliation occurs when an employer takes an adverse action against an employee for engaging in protected activity. (US Dept. of Labor)
    - An adverse action is an action which would dissuade a reasonable employee from raising a concern about a possible violation or engaging in other related protected activity. Retaliation can have a negative impact on overall employee morale.
    - 2. Protecting the anonymity of the whistleblower themselves? Language on this
      - a) Depends on the identity/type of the whistleblower?
      - b) Explain to what extent it will be anonymous-provide some examples
  - D. BP7800 Incompatible Activities
    - 1. Question on who determines whether the employment outside of the District is in conflict/incompatible
    - 2. Some of the language should be included in an AP
      - a) Check to see if there is an AP; there is no draft in progress (AP 2710 loosely related or possibly as a guide to create a new AP?)
