#### What is the Writing Center all about?

- ►One-on-one tutoring on any writing assignment for any class
- ► Thirty minute sessions
- ▶ Focus determined by the student
- ▶ Help at any point in the writing process
- ▶ Beneficial for writers at all levels
- ► A proven key to student success at SBCC:

Students who use the Writing Center have better outcomes in their classes!

#### How we help you become a better writer

- ► We help you gain strength and independence as a writer by supporting you in the learning process and connecting you with resources
  - YOU set the agenda
  - Participate in a student-centered dialogue
    - Build on what you already know
    - Enhance critical thinking skills
    - Increase self-awareness
  - Leave with a plan for what to do next
- ► We are not a repair shop for papers
  - Tutors will not correct or edit papers

## Using the Writing Center

- **▶** Hours
  - ▶ Fall & Spring
    - ▶ Mon Thurs: 9 am 7 pm
    - Fri: 9 am 3 pm
  - **▶** Summer
    - Mon-Thurs: 9 am 4 pm
    - Fri: 9 am I pm
- Appointments and drop-in available
  - ▶ Come by or call (ext. 2663) to make appointment
  - ▶ After 3 misses, no more appointments for the semester
- ► Visit the center up to 3x per week
  - Not more than once per day

Insider's Tip:

Make appointments in advance and well ahead of when the paper is due.
