The Japanese Culture Club

- ARTICLE I NAME
The Name of this organization is The Japanese Culture Club.
- ARTICLE II PURPOSE
The Japanese Culture Club has been organized to promote awareness of and appreciation for the Japanese culture and language, and to stimulate cultural exchange between members.
- ARTICLE III STRUCTURE
An elected president, in co-operation with the club's advisor, will be responsible for the structure and order of meetings and events. All decisions that necessitate a vote will be passed by a simple majority of members present during the vote.
- ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP
Membership is open to any person who is enrolled as a student at Santa Barbara City College, full or part-time.
- ARTICLE V OFFICERS
The offices of this club are that of president, secretary, and treasurer. Officers are to be elected at the initial meeting of each academic year, by a simple majority. The term of office is one academic year. Officers may serve multiple terms.
1. President – is responsible for coordinating the activities of the club, and presides at meetings.
 2. Secretary – is responsible for the correspondence of the club, and presides at meetings not attended by the president.
 3. Treasurer – collects dues of the organization and keeps a record of the club's finances.
- ARTICLE VI MEETINGS
Regular meetings of the organization will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting held within one month after the beginning of semester classes.
- ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS
A majority vote of the general membership will be required to pass amendments to this constitution.
