Santa Barbara SBCC Scuba Club shall serve three purposes – education, service, fellowship.

The SBCC Scuba Club shall be governed by an elected board of students to include but not restricted to, the positions of President, Vice-president, Secretary and Treasurer.

The aforementioned positions shall be elected from the club membership during the last meeting of each semester to serve positions during the following semester.

The duties of each officer shall be as follows:

- ◆ President – conduct meetings following Robert’s Rules of Order, case deciding vote in case of a tie.
- ◆ Vice-President – fills in when president is unavailable, supports president, acts as Scuba Club rep at SBCC Club meetings.
- ◆ Secretary – take minutes of meetings and read minutes of last meeting, to post notices of club activities, alternate Scuba club rep at SBCC Club meetings.
- ◆ Treasurer – Handles Scuba Club finances and membership record keeping.

Members of the SBCC Scuba Club must be interested Scuba diving and be students or faculty currently enrolled at SBCC.

The SBCC Scuba Club will hold regular meetings on the first Wednesday of each month. Special meetings may be called with at least three days notice in the form of a written announcement posted at locations about campus.

This constitution may be amended at any time, in whole or part, by passage of amendments by a simple majority of the SBCC Scuba Club membership in attendance when votes are taken.
