P&R Recommendations to the Academic Senate on 2015-2016 PR Resource Requests

- 1. Move forward all vetted #1 Replacement Equipment requests (excluding classroom and lab furniture and two high-cost items): \$313,751.
- 2. Recommend the following order of priority for equipment:
 - a. #1 Replacement Equipment (\$313,751)
 - b. Item 30: Human Patient Simulator (support in revised amount of \$80,000)
 - c. rank order of New Equipment requests (ballot shared at 2/11/15 Senate meeting)

#1s: \$53,572.30#2s: \$63,899.00#3s: \$5,825

(Note: Items 51 and 52 from Chemistry (iPad covers and cart) have been removed from the ranking sheet after confirmation that the department has already funded the items from another source.)

- 3. Further, P&R endorses item 44 (\$150,000): the transition from multiple smaller vans to the purchase of a 32-passenger bus which will more safely and efficiently accommodate large groups, especially 14 athletic teams that must travel for competition. Specifically, P&R recommends that the College develop a plan to fund the bus over time. This bus would replace some (but not all) of the smaller shuttle buses the College currently has.
- 4. Communicate with department chairs and program managers about how to follow up on "Other" and "Service" tab requests.

Re: 2015-2016 Program Review Ranking for Faculty-led Educational Programs and DTC input.

Follow-up: ITC is requesting approval from Senate to go with the ranked list from DTC.

ITC presented its rankings to District Technology committee on 2/20/2015.

Discussion to strike a balance between infrastructure and classroom technology needs.

DTC made a motion to support ITC rankings as presented on spreadsheets. Further discussion will take place at CPC where all area rankings will be seen for the first time. CPC will make a decision regarding what actual dollars might be allocated for all program review items.

It was agreed that refresh funding (\$572,417.00) would not be used as part of the funding discussion for program review requests and would remain as in previous years.

The rankings from DTC in numerical order:

- Hardware replacement \$124K (includes media enhanced classrooms)
- 2. Wi-Fi \$175K (Partial expansion of classroom Wi-Fi)
- 3. VMWare \$135K (three year cost for expanded licenses, this amount is already adjusted for the \$80K we would spend next year for maintenance on existing licenses)
- 4. Software new \$65K (Time clock, DSPS document mgmt.)
- 5. Hardware new \$399K If there is money allocated for new ITC 's recommendation is to fund ITC's hardware new items starting with top ranked items.
 - 1st Motion and 2nd motion for DTC to support ITC ranked items as presented.

 - Request from DTC to forward this decision to ITC and Academic Senate.
