General comments about SBCC financial situation:

There were obvious impacts during the 4-5 years when California state financial situation affected all levels of education. However, recently economy is improving, more revenues are flowing to education, and state is repaying earlier deferred payments to community colleges.

And, yes, SBCC needed to recover some lost FTEs and funds. Due to SBCC Foundation help, grants, and other funding sources, we weathered the worst of the financial problems. How is it that now we suddenly cannot balance our finances without having 2 Summer Sessions? There were real costs associated with having 2 sessions. Are those costs assigned to that, or just rolled in fiscal year accounting?
