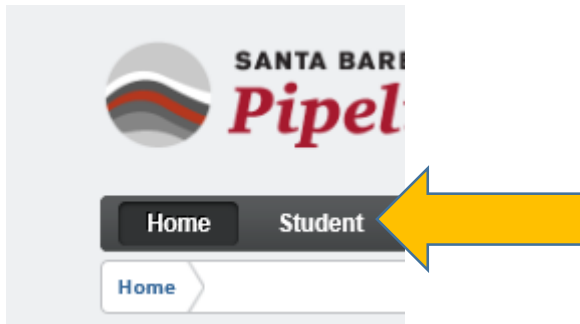
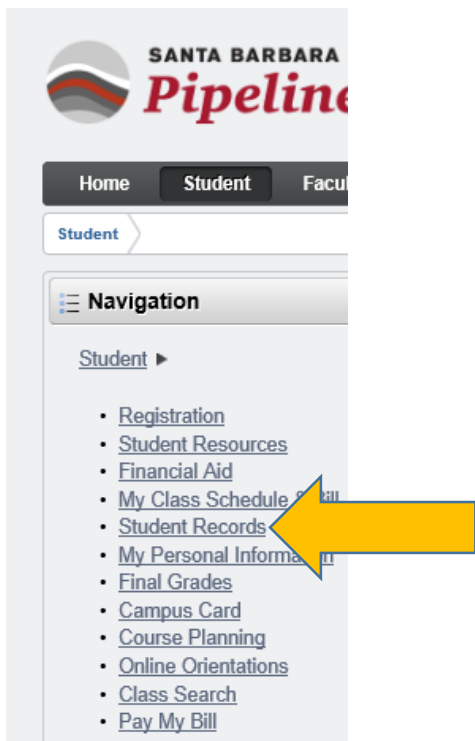


**Step 1:** Log in to your Pipeline account

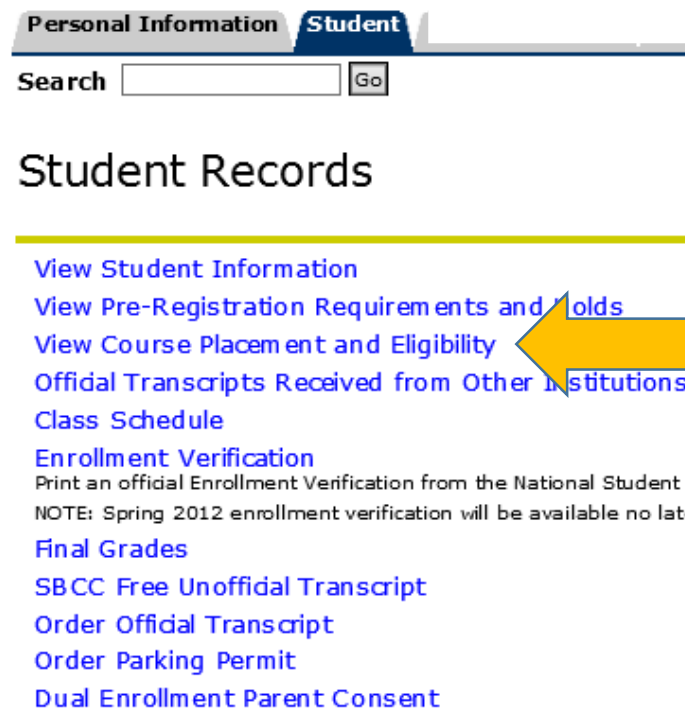
**Step 2:** Click on “Student”
