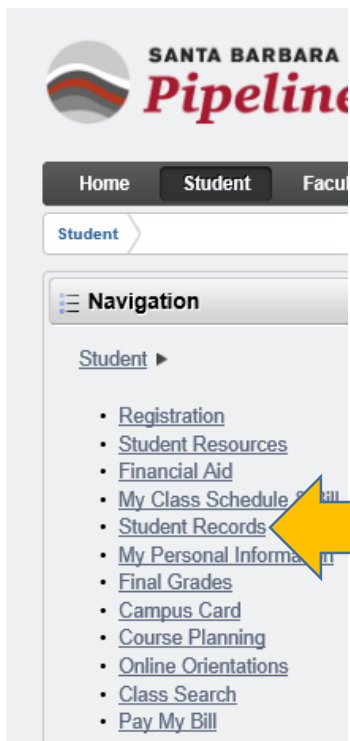


Step 1: Log in to your Pipeline account

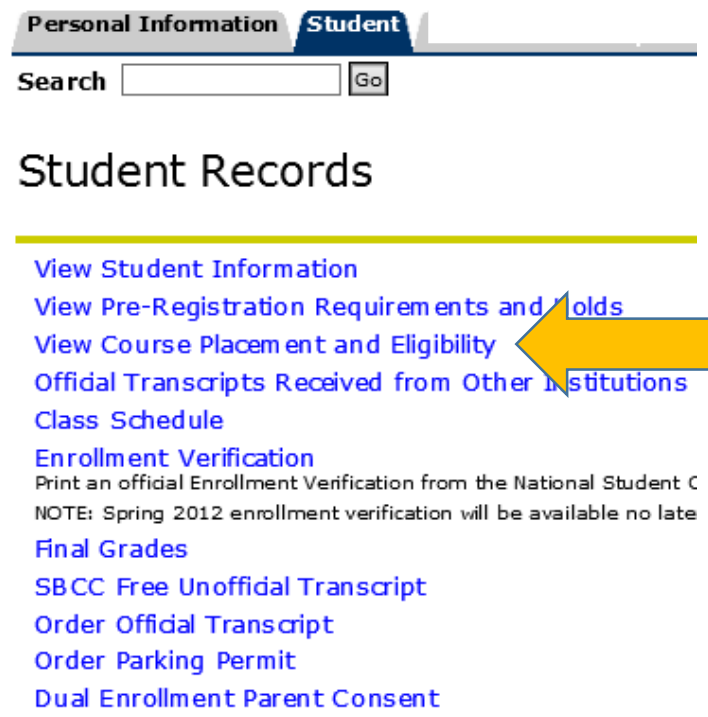
Step 2: Click on “Student”
