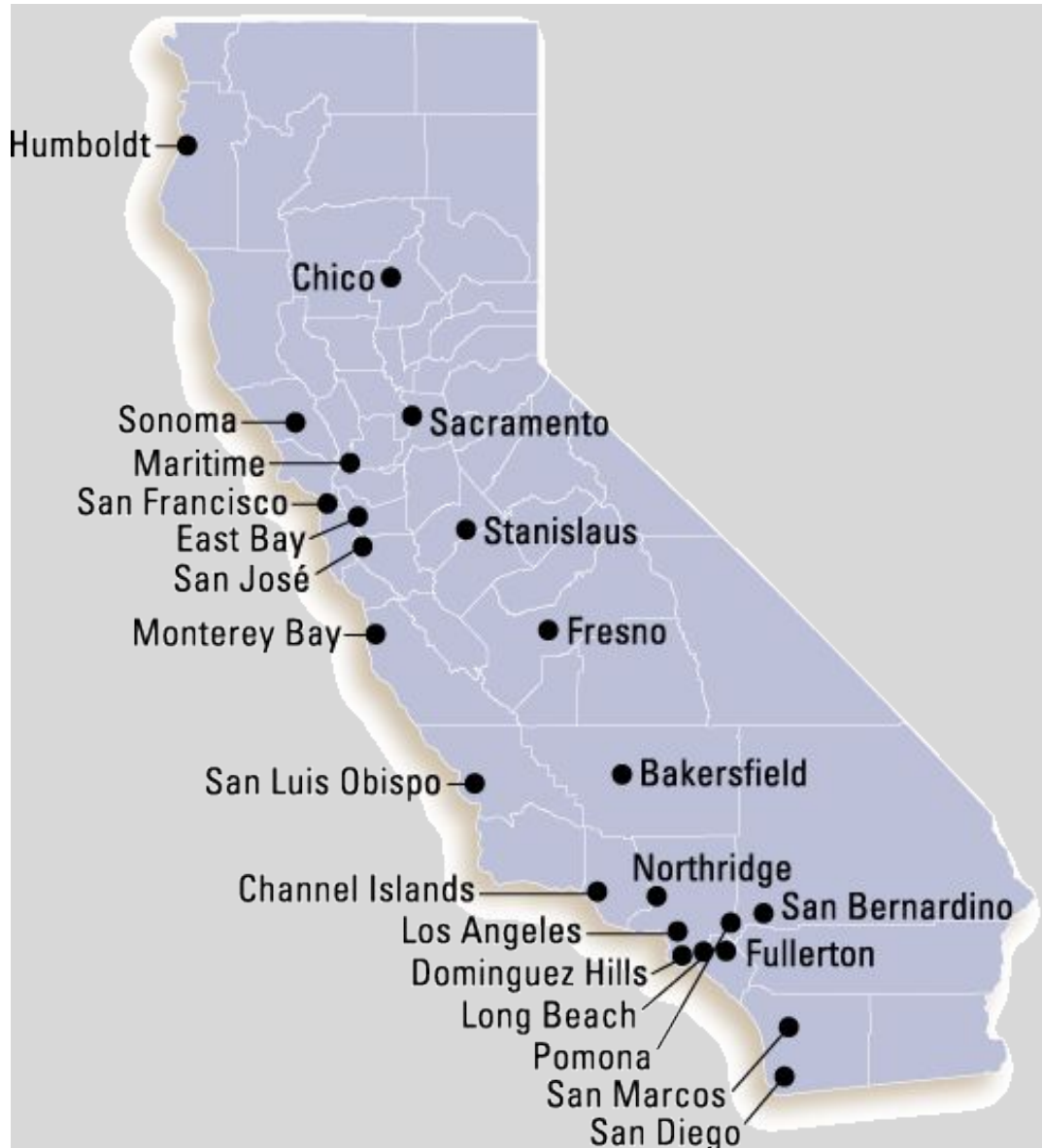

## Transcript Entry

- You will need; unofficial transcripts from all colleges attended and AP or IB scores.
  - Go to Pipeline to print SBCC unofficials
- Courses with grades and units are self reported in the “Transcript Entry” section.
- Include everything regardless of transferability.
- Input in chronological order from start date to current.

# Application Fee and Fee Waiver

Application Fee is \$55 per campus

## Fee Waivers:

- ★ Covers 4 Campuses
- ★ EOPS students should select EOPS fee waiver.
- ★ Eligibility for everyone else is determined after you select “submit”



# Associate Degree For Transfer (ADT) AAT & AST

What are the benefits?

- Students who earn an ADT degree and meet the CSU minimum eligibility requirements are guaranteed admission to the CSU system. This is not a guarantee into a particular campus or major.
- With the ADT, you may be given a GPA bump when applying to an impacted campus outside **your local area** or an impacted major that is **deemed similar**.
- In addition, once at the CSU, if you are admitted and enrolled in a designated similar degree program you have the opportunity to complete your bachelor's degree with as little as 60 semester units.

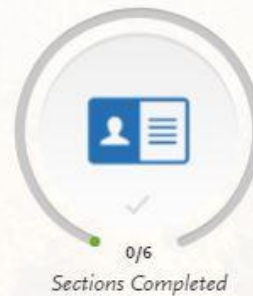

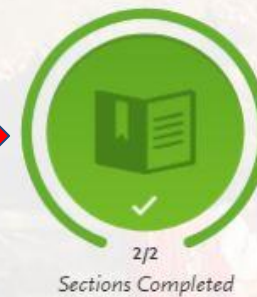
