

If transferring to a specific university is your priority:

- Select the university as soon as possible.
- Find out the required courses, GPA, and units required for admission plus any supplemental requirements.
- You should complete all courses required to meet minimum eligibility requirements.
- Achieve the highest grades possible, especially if the university is selective.
- Research the majors the university offers. Apply to a major that interests you and has a high admit rate (not impacted/ selective).
